

Turais Scoile / Imeachtaí lasmuigh den scoil

Tá sé de dhualgas ar chuile mhúinteoir cead scríofa a fháil ó thuismitheoirí/caomhnóirí nuair atá an rang ag dul ar thuras scoile nó ar imeachtaí scoile lasmuigh den scoil.

Scríosfar na nótaí ceadaithe i ndiaidh an turais/imeacht scoile ach amháin má tharlaíonn aon chineál eachtra. Sa chás sin coinneofar na nótaí ceadaithe sínithe agus beidh cuntas faoin eachtra coinnithe ag an múinteoir chomh maith.

Rachaidh beirt mhúinteoir ar thuras scoile/imeachtaí móide duine den fhoireann oideachais speisialta le aon rang ghrúpa (m.sh. rang 1 ar fad) ar thuras a mbíonn bus i gceist. Má bhíonn riachtanais speisialta ag aon pháiste, go dteastaíonn a leithéid uaidh/uaithi, beidh C.R.S. (Cúntóir Riachtanais Speisialta) á thionlacan chomh maith, fiú taobh amuigh de uaireanta scoile.

I gcásanna siúlóidí nádúir/cleachtadh sa séipéal/ranganna snámha/ imeachtaí spóirt glacfaidh an múinteoir freagracht ar an ngrúpa. Tá polasaí ar leith ag an scoil maidir le ranganna snámha.

Tabharfaidh an múinteoir bosca garchabhair agus aon leigheas, bainteach le páistí sa rang ag a bhfuil ailléirge &rl. orthu, leo.

Fáiltíonn an scoil roimh chabhair ó thuismitheoirí i dtaobh turais/imeachtaí scoile, ag cur eiteas na scoile ó thaobh na Gaeilge de san áireamh, agus an dualgas maidir le grinnfhiosriúchán an Gharda Síochána don ról.

School tours/outings

Every teacher is required to obtain written permission from parents/guardians when the class goes on a school tour or outing outside of the school environs.

The permissions are not retained after the school tour/outing except in the event that an incident has occurred on the tour/outing. In such cases the permission slips are retained and a written report of the incident is also kept on file by the class teacher.

Two teachers and an SET (Special Education Teacher) will accompany school tours or whole class outing (e.g. all of rang 1) where a bus is required. If a child has special needs, which require same, an SNA will accompany the child even if the tour/outing extends beyond normal school hours.

In the case of nature walks/ church practices/swimming classes/sporting events the teacher will assume responsibility for the group under his or her care. The school has a separate policy in relation to swimming classes.

The teacher will bring a first-aid kit and any other necessary medication relating to specific children in the group who have allergies, etc.

The school welcomes help from parents in relation to school tours/outings, bearing in mind the school ethos in relation to Gaeilge, and the obligations in relation to Garda Vetting for the role.
